#### **Career Path**

career path.

The career paths available are subject to partner operators available and operator demand at any given time. These options are subject to change.




First Officer position with Icelandair flying the Boeing 757, 767 or 737

## The Career Path Financing

Financing options of career path vary according to the options chosen in partnership between the operator and the candidate and will vary.

The student can commit to any of the available career paths available once having successfully completed the assessment program.



#### 1. Confirmation Fee

Payable upon signing the training agreement.

Both school and student commit to the training and payment plan.

#### 2. School Fee

Payable 2 weeks before school start

At this point, the student is fully committed to the course and subject to non-refundable termination fee of 6.000€

#### 3. School Fee

At this point, the student should have completed minimum FEIN units to be eligible for financing with LÍN and Framtíðin

The financing options exceed the school fees at this point, which allows the student to refinance the first payment and living expenses

#### 4. School Fee

Framtíðin can cover the entire last amount of the payment plan

Career Paths such as the Icelandair Cadet Program may help finance the program as well
