## Private Pilot Licence (PPL)

The Private Pilot Licence course is composed of both ground school and flight training. Keilir Aviation Academy usually offers two PPL courses each year, in the spring and in the fall.

The practical element of the Private Pilot course may be completed in conjunction with the ground school or separately, although we do recommend them being taken at the same time. Ground training is 150 hours via distance learning, and minimum flight time to complete the course is 45 hours. The endorsement for flying an aircraft for the first time as the sole occupant is the first challenge to the PPL student.

## Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL)

The aim of the CPL(A) modular course is to train PPL(A) holders to the level of proficiency necessary for the issue of a CPL(A). Ground training requirements can be accomplished by completing the ATPL Theory Course either at Keilir Aviation Academy or another JAR-FCL approved FTO. Flight training consists of 25 hours flight instruction, taking approximately six weeks.

A pilot with a valid CPL issued in accordance with ICAO Annex 1, may be entitled to a reduction in the minimum flight hours required (25 hours), depending on our assessment of the piloting skill and knowledge at the start of training.

## Airline Transport Pilot Licence (ATPL)

The ATPL theory course is designed to facilitate understanding of the necessary principles in aviation and prepare pilots for the airline environment. Certified Airline Transport Pilots are authorized to act as pilot-in-command of aircraft in scheduled air carrier service. Keilir Aviation Academy offers both a distance learning programme and a full-ground course.

## Instrument Rating (IR)

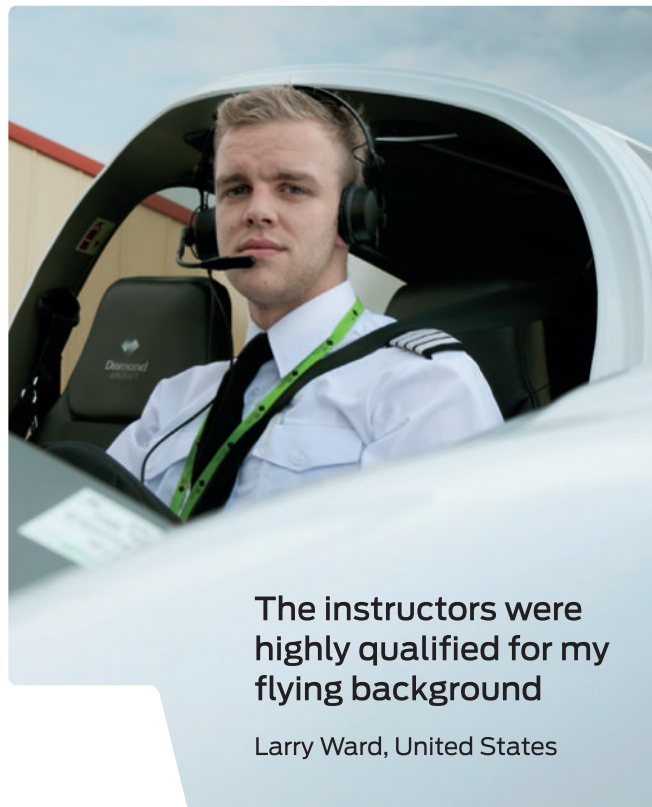
During instrument rating on multi engine aircraft, students train on the DA42 NG, equipped with TKS De-icing System and EFIS with Synthetic Vision System. Pilots with previous experience and ratings in ICAO licences may qualify for a reduction in the minimum required flight hours.

## Instructor Ratings

Pilots may want to expand their knowledge and skill even further by enrolling in Flight Instructor Course at Keilir. During the course students will get familiar with the basics of teaching and learning, instruction techniques and conduct comprehensive analysis of both the Private and Commercial Pilots Flight Training Syllabi. Further ratings for instrument instruction and class rating instruction are also available.

## Air Traffic Control (ATC)

During the initial course the student will acquire the skills to handle complex and dense air traffic situations and it prepares the student for the next stage of training. Air Traffic Control courses at Keilir consist of: Basic/Initial Course, Aerodrome Control Instrument Rating with Tower Endorsement (ADI/TWR), Approach Control Procedural (APP) and Approach Control Surveillance (ACS).
