He specialises in probabilistic assessments of earthquake and volcanic hazards and risks.

Dr. Aspinall is a Member of the Scientific Committee of the IAEA International Safety Centre, and a member of the British Government Scientific Advisory Committees on Montserrat Volcanic Activity and on the Icelandic volcanic ash emergency.
